LCHS Valedictorian Selection Criteria

The Valedictorian is the student who has achieved the highest academic standing in the Grade 12 graduating class and who embodies the core values of Leduc Composite High School.

1. Academic Requirements

The Valedictorian is determined by calculating the highest cumulative average grade across the following required subject areas:

- **Mandatory Courses:**
 - English Language Arts 30-1
 - Social Studies 30-1
- **Other Academic Courses:**
 - Three courses from the following six academic options:
 - Biology 30
 - Chemistry 30
 - Mathematics 30-1
 - Mathematics 31
 - Physics 30
 - French Language Arts 30-1

2. Calculation Timeline

The average will be calculated at the end of Quarter 3. Marks used will include completed course final marks and Quarter 3 marks for any courses still in progress during Semester 2.

3. School Core Values

In addition to academic achievement, the Valedictorian must:

- Meet all graduation requirements, including earning a minimum of 110 credits.
- Be in good standing with Leduc Composite High School.
