On July 17, 2026, diploma exam marks from the June examinations will be available on *myPass* on the Alberta Education website. Diploma examination appeals are made via direct contact with Alberta Education after July 17, 2026. - *Students will need their ASN #s for access if not previously set up.*

REGISTRATION OF NEW STUDENTS

All new families are to register their child(ren) online via PowerSchool Registration which is available on the Black Gold School Division website at: [New Student Registration](#)

We welcome new students to our LCHS community. We offer English (grades 8 to 12) and French Immersion (grades 10-12 only) instructional programming for the 2026/27 school year.

Families will be contacted for appointments once registration has been processed. Grade 11 and 12 students will need to bring a copy of their transcripts or the previous year Report Card in order to select courses. **Please note that students from outside of the designated LCHS attendance area may not be accepted.**

RETURNING STUDENTS - VERIFICATION FORM

Students who were attending a Black Gold School Division (BGSD) school in 2025-2026 and are returning to a BGSD school in 2026-2027 are automatically registered for the 2026-2027 school year.

All BGSD families are required to complete the Student Enrollment Verification Form for the 2026-2027 school year. In late August, parents/guardians will receive an email via SchoolMessenger with details on how to access this form.
