School Fees

Please check your PowerSchool Parent Portal for any posted school fees under "Student Fees & Forms." If you have any questions, please contact the school at 780-986-2248.

These fees are based on enrollment and are used in full to support our students. They help fund essential classroom supplies, field trips, and hands-on learning opportunities. We appreciate your prompt payment, as it allows us to continue offering these high-quality programs.

Please note that any outstanding fees will be forwarded to Black Gold School Division office and forwarded on to a collections agency.

IMPORTANT YEAR-END & EXAM INFORMATION

- **No late entry will be permitted for any Diploma Exams** after 10:00 AM.
- **Supplies:** Students must bring all required supplies needed for their specific exams, including pencils, pens, and working calculators (fully charged or with fresh batteries).
- **Junior High Students:** The “**JH Final Exam - Permission to Leave Form**” will be **available on the PowerSchool Parent Portal starting Monday, June 1st.**
- **Library Book Returns:** Please remind your students to return all library books ASAP.
- **Textbook Returns:** Any textbooks that are no longer being used can be returned as early as June 12th. Students are welcome to keep textbooks longer if needed for studying, however, they must bring the textbook to the exam room on the day of that specific exam so it can be returned immediately afterward. **Please note: Student accounts will be fined for any books that are not returned.**
- **Locker Clean-Out Dates: High School Students on June 12th and Junior High Students on June 17th.** Any items left in lockers after these respective dates will be discarded.
- **Report cards will be accessible via PowerSchool by June 26th.** An email will be sent out to families as soon as they are officially posted.
- **Parents of graduating students and students who are not returning next year will only have until mid-August to view and download report cards on the parent portal.**
- **Graduating students will also be able to access their final marks via MyPASS.**

Junior High Exam Schedule

All Junior High exams begin promptly at 9:00 AM. Students are expected to be in their assigned room and seated, ready to begin writing at this time. Room assignments for each exam will be posted in Google Classrooms.

Students must remain in the exam room until 10:00 AM. Upon completion of their exam, students will be directed to study hall. Students will only be permitted to leave the school if a parent/guardian has completed the “JH Final Exam Permission to Leave Form” on the PowerSchool Parent Portal, authorizing them to do so.

LCHS Work Experience Program

The Black Gold Regional Division Off-Campus Education Program is all about students learning valuable work skills beyond the walls of their school. A company work site within their community becomes their 'classroom'.

The purpose of this program is to familiarize students with the world of work. Real-life resumes and interviews can help them land a quality job, while customized skill and safety training give students the opportunity to excel at their work site.

Students will also earn up to a maximum of 30 credits in Work Experience, 15 of which can be used towards their high school diploma. 25 hours of work equals 1 credit.

Off-Campus Programs

Divide your time between:

- your school, to take courses such as English Language Arts, Mathematics, and Social Studies to meet the requirements of high school graduation, and
- an approved work site, for on-the-job training in a trade of your choice.

As you work, you will earn:

- at least minimum wage,
- up to 41 high school credits (40 RAP credits, plus 1 CTS safety credit), and
- on-the-job training hours toward an apprenticeship program.

After you complete high school,

- continue working in your trade to earn additional on-the-job hours required to complete the full apprenticeship education program in your trade,
- attend and pass in-class training at a post-secondary institution between and 6 and 12 weeks per year of the program, depending on the trade,
- pass the required exam at the end of each year of your program, and complete your apprenticeship program to earn your journey person certification and apprenticeship education credential.

MYPASS ACCOUNT

PLEASE ENCOURAGE YOUR CHILDREN TO CREATE A MYPASS ACCOUNT. IT IS IMPORTANT FOR ALL HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS TO HAVE A MYPASS ACCOUNT THROUGH ALBERTA EDUCATION.

The MyPass Account can be used to

- Access the student's DAR (detailed academic report) which includes their credit count and all of the high school courses they have taken with their final grades Access the student's credential report which includes all of the graduation requirements that are completed and incomplete
 - Students can choose between credentials for an Alberta High School Diploma or the credentials for a Certificate of High School Achievement (KAE certificate)
- Access the student's Diploma exam results (this is the ONLY way to see these results) Obtain a High School Transcript for themselves or to be mailed to a post-secondary institution.

What is the myBlueprint Education Planner?

myBlueprint Education Planner is a student-friendly, interactive education and career/life planning tool that Black Gold junior high and high school students use to make the most informed decisions about their future.

myBlueprint allows students to visually plan towards graduation requirements while instantly discovering their eligibility for every post-secondary pathway in Canada, or compare information on apprenticeships, programs, and occupations to ensure they make better decisions and are more prepared for their futures after high school.

Students also learn the basics of financial literacy and money management, and discover what employers are looking for with job search tools tied directly to the student's occupations of interest.

As a parent/guardian, can I access myBlueprint Education Planner?

Yes! To explore the features of **myBlueprint**, you can create a Family Account and link to your child's account (requires student permission).

With direct access from home, you can get more informed and involved with your child's education, and support your child in making the most informed decisions about their future.

Why would I want access to myBlueprint Education Planner?

The family account allows you to view student artifacts and reflections, including the goals they are setting, careers they are interested in, and what they are learning in school.

You can log in to your account to comment on your child's work or receive messages from their teacher(s). Keep in mind that the Family Account has read-only access for linked student accounts – it does not allow you to complete activities or post to portfolios within the student's account.
