

Grade 10s,

You will be registering for **Grade 11** during the week after spring break. We will be coming to one of your classes. Both the registration form and the Course Handbook are linked to this post.

You can use the registration form to plan which courses you are interested in taking next year. There is a different form if you are a French Immersion student.

To graduate with a High School Diploma, the requirements include:

100 credits

Grade 12 level of both English and Social Studies

Grade 11 level of Math and Science

PhysEd 10

CALM

10 option credits (CTS/Fine Arts/Second Languages)

10 30-level credits (not English or Social Studies)

It is expected that students in the diploma stream will complete Grade 11 with at least 75 credits and credit in a 20-level course of Math, Science, Social and English.

For French Immersion students, to earn a Bilingual Certificate, the requirements are:

40 credits in French Immersion courses that must include:

FLA 10, FLA 20, FLA 30

another French Immersion course at the 30-level

To graduate with a Certificate of High School Achievement (K&E certificate), the requirements include:

80 credits

English 20-2 or 30-4, Social 10-2 or 20-4, Math 10-3 or 20-4, Science 14 or 20-4

PhysEd 10

CALM

5 30-level CTS credits AND 5 30-level WorkEx Credits; OR 5 30-level RAP credits

It is expected that K&E students will complete Grade 11 with:

At least 60 credits

credit in all of the 20-level core classes.

5 credits in at least one 20-level CTS class (that has a 30-level)

5 credits in Work Experience 15 or 25

Completing the Registration Form

Fill in the following template as you choose courses. There are 4 blocks in each semester. This template is to help you keep track of how many courses you need to choose. When the courses take place will be determined later.

Remember: for a 3-credit class, divide the block into two parts.

There are three sections in the registration form:

Section 1:

This is where you select your core courses. If you have not already taken PhysEd 10 and CALM, you will need to register for these courses.

Section 2:

This is where you select your electives. Only select enough classes to fill in your timetable.

If you are passing all of your core classes in Grade 10 AND will earn at least 40 credits, you are permitted to take a single spare in Grade 11.

Section 3:

Alternative Electives: These courses are your second choices, in case you are unable to get into an elective chosen in Section 2.
