

## Leduc Composite High School Bilingual Certificate Requirements

In order for a student to receive a bilingual certificate from Leduc Composite High School, he or she must have taken a minimum of:

FLA 10-1, 20-1 or 20-2, 30-1 or 30-2 as well as 6 other courses from which 2 of them are taken at the 30 level for a total of a *minimum of 45 credits*.

**(each course represents 5 credits)**
