1. Celebrations!
 - a. Mrs. Entz, Miss Acorn and Mrs. Thiessen will be returning to LCHS in the fall.
2. The small gym and sci lab renos are moving ahead
 - a. Small gym - the ceiling is being painted and the flooring is acclimatizing.
 - b. Sci Lab - Plans are complete and demolition is to start soon.
3. Remote learning - Minister Lagrange confirmed today that remote learning will continue for the remainder of the year.
4. Registration process is underway.
 - a. Students will submit their course choices via a Google form.
 - b. Grade 10s have been pre-enrolled in appropriate core classes based on their grade 9 term 2 marks. Parents can contact admin to make changes.
 - c. Grade 11 and 12 registration is being coordinated through Tiger's DEN.
 - d. We held a live Q&A on April 27 for incoming 10s.
5. Grad - The school is waiting on availability of venues for a postponed grad celebration.

- a. We need to come up with a contingency plan if venues are not available.

6. Assessment

- a. No final exams
- b. Final grades will be calculated. Some key points:
 - i. If a student was passing on March 13, they will have a minimum of 50% for a final grade.
 - ii. If a student was not passing on March 13, they could fail the course but will have the opportunity to pass.
 - iii. All students have the opportunity to improve their marks with the completion of assignments.
 - iv. The impact of remote learning has been limited to 30% of the final grade.
 - 1. In most cases this will not adversely affect student grades. Teachers will have the opportunity to adjust grades in accordance with an assessment of student mastery of outcomes. This will occur in June.
 - v. If a student loses out on credits as a result of COVID 19, we can assign "unallocated credits."
