REGISTRATION OF NEW STUDENTS

All new families are to register their child(ren) online via PowerSchool Registration which is available on the Black Gold School Division website at: New Student Registration

We welcome new students to our LCHS community. We offer English and French Immersion instructional programming for Grades 10, 11 and 12 for 2023/24 school year.

Fill out all the information in the above registration form and save. New student registrations will take place in August. Please call the main office on August 23, 2023, to book an appointment. You will need to bring a copy of your child's birth certificate and previous year's grades when you come to the school to select courses. Please note that due to increased enrollment, LCHS is not accepting students from outside of our designated attendance boundaries.

RETURNING STUDENTS - VERIFICATION FORM

Students who were attending a Black Gold School Division (BGSD) school in 2022-2023 and are returning to a BGSD school in 2023-2024 are automatically registered for the 2023-2024 school year.

All BGSD families are expected to complete the Student Enrollment Verification Form for the 2023-2024 school year. In late August, parents/guardians will receive an email via SchoolMessenger with details on how to access this form during the first week of school.
